

## *Will the Killer Profit?*

**The Problem:** Losing a loved one to domestic violence is tragic. Too often, there is a yet a second injustice to which surviving families are frequently caught unaware - the killer may try to financially profit from their crime.

How? In domestic violence deaths, the killer is usually the spouse, lover, or family member of the victim. Therefore, the killer is often in a position to know private financial information, including: bank accounts; pay checks; life insurance policies; investments; and other assets. Sometimes these assets are much larger than even the surviving family is aware.

Arizona law states that killers are to be disinherited and cannot profit from their crime. The problem is that this is NOT part of the criminal justice system, and no one is enforcing the law until it is too late.

As a result, while the rest of the family is grieving, the killer may attempt to profit even if the killer has already been caught and is in jail because a killer may drain the assets by mail, phone, internet, or through a friend. If the killer obtains the assets, it is very difficult if not impossible to ever get it back, since the killer will usually spend or hide the assets quickly.

Once families eventually learn that the killer actually profited from the death of their loved one, they feel as if a second tragedy and injustice has been suffered at the hands of the killer.

What can be done to stop this injustice?

## *Injustice Can Be Prevented*

**Our Solution:** The Never Again Foundation is a *non profit charity* that gives legal assistance to families of victims killed by domestic violence. We help and guide you through probate to legally obtain the assets. We also file legal notices and lawsuits to disqualify the killer as an heir. Our non profit mission is to prevent all killers from financially profiting from causing death, and instead fight to have the assets go to the rightful and appropriate family members of the victim.

No other government or non profit agency provides this critical legal service to families.

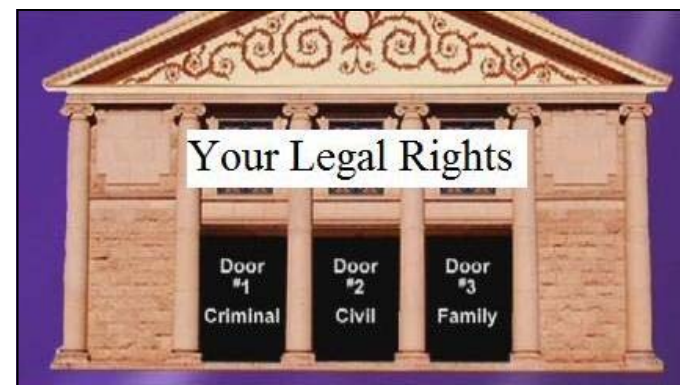
